Vigils will take place at the following locations to honor the memories of the victims:



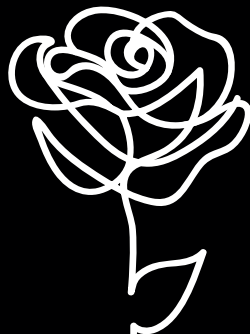
